Good afternoon and welcome to the 94th Annual Meeting for Linkage Credit Union. On behalf of the Board of Directors, I would like to thank you for attending and taking an active interest in your credit union.

It has been my honor to serve as the Chairman for the Board of Directors for the last 5 years. Our Board remains united with our commitment in making the best decisions for your credit union.

We are responsible for ensuring your credit union has qualified leadership – and I can say without hesitation that we do. With a combined 55 years of knowledge, the management and staff take great pride in their service to you. On behalf of the Board, I would like to thank the management and staff for their unwavering service!

Our credit union has continued with positive financial growth in 2024, ending the year with a net income of \$88,445 being added to our retained earnings. Linkage remains well capitalized with a net worth ratio of 18.27%, up from 16.96% in 2023. Our membership remains strong at 2,114 members, with 521 of those being borrowers as well.

As we celebrate 94 years in business, our mission remains to meet the needs of our members and excel in customer service while providing honest and quality financial services.

Credit Committee Report

The credit union approved 370 new money loans in 2024 for \$4,346,345.46.

The total dollar amount of all loans outstanding to our members, including VISA credit cards and overdrafts as of the year-end was **\$10,387,623.87**

Supervisory Report

The Board of Directors engaged the services of Credit Union Resources to perform a supervisory examination of the credit union as of September 30, 2024. The board confirms the results were satisfactory.
